their blue and tan coloration as they mature.

Size: Weight: not to exceed 7 lb; Height: 8-9"

Coat: Long silky hair, which should be fine, glossy, and perfectly straight

Temperament: Ever eager for adventure, and trouble. Busy, inquisitive, bold,

stubborn.
