

Breed Standards for the Affenpinscher

General Appearance and Coat:	Its rough coat is about 1 inch long on the body, somewhat longer on the head, neck, chest, stomach and legs. This coat type provided protection from vermin and harsh conditions.
Head & Neck:	Under shot, short muzzle, domed skull, well-defined Stop, ears both cropped to a point and erect, or UN cropped and erect, semi-erect, or drop
Front Quarters:	Small, round feet
Hind Quarters:	Tail natural or docked 1-3" long, carried erect
Special Characteristics:	Black, gray, silver, or black and tan
Gait and Movement:	The gait is light, sound, and confident
Temperament:	Very playful, busy, inquisitive, bold, and stubborn
