

Breed Standards for the Bedlington Terrier

General Appearance and Coat:	Its coat is a mixture of hard and soft hair standing off the skin
Head and Neck:	Eyes almond shaped, skull narrow, deep and rounded, no stop, profuse top knot, ears triangular with rounded tips, hanging, set low with a silky tassel at tip
Front Quarters:	Hare feet
Hind Quarters:	Back has arch over loin, good tuck-up
Special Characteristics:	Blue, sandy, and liver, each with or without tan points, Bedlington pups are born dark, and lighten to adult color by about one year of age
