| General Appearance: | A strong head that is always well-covered with hair and has rough, bushy eyebrows. |
| Coat: | The length of the coat varies considerably from 1.5 – 4 ". It is rough, harsh, abundant and thick, forming a mane on neck and withers. The harsh undercoat should also be well-developed. |
| Color: | Black, Black with gray hairs |
| Size: | Height: 25 – 29" Weight: 80 – 120 lbs |
| Temperament: | Primarily used as a protector and guard dog. This is generally an aggressive dog. |
