

Breed Standards for the Canadian Eskimo Dog

General Appearance:	This dog falls between the larger Alaskan Malamute and smaller Siberian Husky in size.
Coat:	Heavy and impenetrable
Tail:	Large and bushy
Color:	All color or combinations
Size:	Males: Height: 23 – 27"; Weight: 75 – 105lb Female: Height: 20 – 24"; Weight: 60 – 90lb
Temperament:	Expected originally to catch any prey, forming part of the dogs' own food ration, the Eskimo Dog is not a breed to keep with other livestock or dogs.
